

In my opinion, why should we burden God with our trivial concerns when the harmony among us is something we should be responsible for, rather than attributing it to God?


God can be understood as the universal consciousness encompassing all of existence.

GAME


 $\mathrm{W}^{\mathrm{hat}}$ do the Gods do when they have nothing to do?


ILLUSIONS


This dissatisfaction can also pave the way toward exploring other sexual orientations, such as being gay or lesbian.

This issue is not solely physical; it is also a mental phenomenon.




CHAPTER VI

T he ongoing debate over male versus female superiority has yielded no definitive answers, as it is rooted in bias.


The question of whether God is male or female only adds to this divide. In reality, the soul is genderless, and the physical body is merely a vessel for us to participate in life's game, regardless of gender.

If not, they have a feeling of being isolated from the entire world. They somehow become strangers to themselves and they feel that the only escape is death!

It's like not even playing the game. Quitting after a lot of struggles; right from competing with millions of sperms to attain this life and the privilege of being human, which could have been the final stage of liberation.

I don't think that's a fair deal!

The Easiest way would be to give a suicidal person example of those who have taken their lives despite them having similar (materialistic/ emotional) reasons. E.g. Person "A" decides to end his/her life, the reason being money. He/she should be given an example of someone who has committed suicide despite having money.

Everyone has their reasons to end their lives, but if we dig deep, those reasons are part of the illusion. No one likes to share their suffering because of their insecurities, so they are never willing to help others, which could have been done by sharing their own experiences.

If one chooses to live a life in which no other being is harmed, especially when it comes to seeking personal pleasures, be it a protector or a nurturer, that individual should be ready to gear up even if the world is against them.

MEDITATION

Meditation is a journey towards thoughtlessness and reconnecting with our true nature. Rather than focusing on the thoughts that disturb us, we often try to meditate harder while leaving these thoughts unexamined.

This mental turbulence stems from a lack of synchronization with ourselves and the system. To address this, we need to first focus on our thoughts and observe them without bias. By understanding the root causes of our problems, we can gradually eliminate each disruptive thought, leading us to a state of inner harmony and nothingness.

In a meditative state, we align with the present moment and connect with our true selves—our soul.

DEATH

The concept of death we commonly understand is not the end of our true selves—our Soul. Instead, it is merely a transition phase before liberation or reincarnation in a different form to continue the journey toward ultimate freedom.

To comprehend death, we first need to understand life, as they are two sides of the same coin - duality.

When a soul is born into a human body, it forms a connection with the body. Thus, life is a combination of Body and Soul. Initially, we exist in a state of nothingness, akin to a blank slate, similar to a newborn child. Upon birth, the soul connects with the brain, which in turn connects with the body.

As the soul engages with the brain, a human bio-computer, it begins to absorb conditioning from the physical world through interactions with our environment and the teachings of those around us—parents, friends, teachers, and others.

The brain functions as the Intelligent Soul of the body, managing both conscious and subconscious activities. Once we learn something, such as driving or swimming, it is stored in the brain's memory. By practicing to enter this state of nothingness through meditation and removing the factors that hinder this process, we can become truly aware of our true selves (the soul) even before the physical body dies.

This realization allows us to reconnect with our inherent state of immortality, as the soul never truly dies.

DREAMS

A common misconception about dreams is that a divine being enters our dreams to deliver a message.

In reality, dreams happen because we don't experience deep, uninterrupted sleep.

If we can separate the three activities thinking, sleeping, and acting—we will not only see through the fabricated stories of selfproclaimed spiritual leaders but also be able to enjoy a much deeper and more restorative sleep.

LOVE

The only illusion surrounding love is our belief that our hearts are deeply connected to it, while the heart's primary function is merely to pump blood.

When you recognize that you are a part of the Divine, the first step is learning to love yourself, exploring the pleasures of life through all your senses.

As you come to realize that others are also connected to the same Divine essence, you naturally begin to love them as well-choosing to honor them by not causing harm while you continue to explore life's pleasures.

It reinforces the saying " *If Love happens, It happens* with all; otherwise, not even with oneself."

Therefore Illusion can only be dispelled when we align with our true selves by embracing impartiality toward both others and ourselves. This alignment will ultimately guide us toward Enlightenment.

Enlightenment is the journey of rediscovering our true selves and deepening our connection with God.

The term "*Enlightenment*" literally means the process of illuminating darkness.

We are like light bulbs; we simply need to flip the right switch. It's not complicated—just a matter of activating that switch.

When someone is enlightened, their inner light shines brightly, naturally spreading that illumination and bliss to others.
